Project description	<p>Considered the alarmingly low turnout rate in EU elections in some countries where voting is not compulsory and the democratic deficit it causes across Europe, the present project aims to restore electoral faith among EU citizens.</p> <p>It will address the four main causes for low electoral participation found in collaboration with the project partners:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - lack of interest and of knowledge of the democratic workings of the EU - mistrust towards EU institutions -lack of sense of belonging to Europe. <p>IDEA-C will consist of 13 local workshops organised from each partner organization + 4 International events.</p>

About 101 - 125 participants in total with 31 foreign participants + 1 expert from Slovenia + 1 expert from France. • Duration: 2 days for travel + 1 day of meeting (press conference, conferences, session about the dissemination, project documentation, evaluation). • Content: The focus is on the democratic workings of the EU.
