



Programme: Research and Innovation - People; 7th FRAMEWORK PROGRAMME.

Deadlines: August 16th, 2012 - h. 17.00 (Brussels time)

Description: Marie Curie action falls under the specific program "People" of the 7th Framework Programme for research, technological development and demonstration activities (2007-2013). The International Incoming fellowships was created under the Marie Curie actions and aimed at developing cooperation between Europe and the rest of the world in research.

Objectives: This action wants to promote scientific excellence of the Member States and Associated States through the exchange of knowledge with world-class researchers who come from Third Countries (i.e. countries which are neither Member States nor Associated Countries to FP7).

Beneficiaries: Researchers who move from a third country to be housed within an organization of excellence of an EU Member State or Associated Country. To apply, you must be in possession of a doctoral degree or have played at least 4 years of full-time research, after obtaining a diploma giving access to doctoral studies. The higher the level of experience, the better the chance of being selected.

Amount available: € 40 million.

How to participate: The application shall be submitted jointly by eligible senior researcher from the third country together with the host organization. The host organizations can be universities, research centers or enterprises.

The financial support will be provided for a period of 12-24 months (full time equivalents).
